

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program 2017

In 2017, it is <u>compulsory</u> for students in Years 10, 11 and 12 to bring an electronic device of their choosing. For example, a tablet (eg. iPad), laptop or Chromebook (not a smart phone) to support their learning.

Students who wish to bring a personally owned laptop need to:

- Purchase and install one of the following antivirus programs: Trend Micro or Norton. This is to safeguard the integrity of the CLC network. Please note: free antivirus software is not sufficient.
- See a member of the IT department to have the device configured for use on the wireless network and for the antivirus software to be checked.
- Complete and return the agreement below to their homeroom teacher.
