CREATIVITY AND CHOICE

These are the cornerstones of the Year 9 Possibilities Program! We aim to excite our young women in authentic, real-world projects through a series of engaging activities and hands on learning. Leaving the school grounds behind, learning is amplified through our partnerships with the Banyule Nillumbik Tech School, RMIT University and La Trobe University. Students engage in collaborative problem solving that involves investigations in and around the City of Melbourne as well as the local Eltham community.

FUTURE PROOFING

The needs of our young people are changing. Through their work in this program, our students will become more independent learners, confident communicators and creative innovators better equipped for their future, both at school and beyond. Learning is connected to and enhances the core studies and elective programs through hands on application of acquired skills and knowledge. Self and peer assessment empowers students to be reflective, self-regulators and positive, collaborative learners. The program is rich in explicit teaching and real world development of enterprise skills. These are transferable skills which are now considered essential for our young people for their future working lives. These include:
